

Chigwell School Uniform List

Sixth Form Boys

SUIT – Charcoal (ie, dark) grey, navy or black. Single or double breasted. A conventional/traditional cut – no mandarin collars for example. Plain, or with faint pinstripes, but no other obvious pattern. Full length trousers.

or

BLAZER* – Navy, with school badge*, worn with mid-grey trousers.

SHIRT – white

PULLOVER – V-neck, grey, navy or black. Plain knit, no ribbed pattern, stripes, etc. The school tie should be clearly visible.

TIE* - House colours.

SOCKS – grey, charcoal, navy or black.

COAT/RAINCOAT/ANORAK – Plain black, charcoal (dark) grey or navy (must cover jacket).

SHOES – Plain black, polishable. NOT boots.

SCARF – V1th Form school scarf, or plain black or dark grey scarf, only.

BAG or BRIEFCASE for books.

Please note that ostentatious logos or patterns should not appear on any items of the school uniform.

SHORTS – white

TRACKSUIT* (optional)

SWIMMING SHORTS or TRUNKS, navy

TOWEL for swimming/games or ROBE* (optional)

SPORTS BAG

General Appearance

No jewellery or studs to be worn.

Sixth Form Girls

SUITS - grey, navy or black, single or double-breasted and be tailored whether it be a skirt or a trouser suit. It should be plain or with a faint pin-stripe but with no obvious pattern. Skirts should be worn at knee length.

DRESSES - must be a dress suit i.e. a dress with a matching jacket that would be appropriate for a smart business environment.

BLOUSES - should be plain white, clearly designed to be worn without a tie or a plain white shirt to be worn with the House tie.

CARDIGANS - should be plain navy blue, black or grey. These may be worn with a jacket in cold weather but not as a substitute for a jacket. The House tie, if worn, should be clearly visible.

TIGHTS - navy, black or flesh coloured. Plain, not patterned.

COAT/RAINCOAT/ANORAK – Plain black, charcoal (dark) grey or navy (must cover jacket).

SHOES - black. NOT boots.

SCARVES - should be plain.

BAG or BRIEFCASE for books.

Please note that ostentatious logos or patterns should not appear on any items of the school uniform.

TROUSERS, DRESSES & SKIRTS SHOULD BE **TAILORED** AND NOT 'FIGURE-HUGGING/BODY-CON' STYLE
